ABSTRACT GUIDELINES

1. All free papers will be presented as thematic posters (except for those short listed for presentation in the young investigator awards instituted by the ICS/NCCP/Napcon Free paper award). NAPCON has instituted special prizes for poster sessions.
2. Abstracts are invited from the registered delegates for presenting original research and interesting cases.
3. Abstracts have to be sent on the enclosed abstract submission form ALONG with an electronic version in the form of a CD containing the entire abstract in MS word or RTF format.
4. Alternatively the abstracts can be submitted online at www.napcon2011.com However, please ensure that a signed hard copy of the submission reaches the conference secretariat before the deadline.
5. Please restrict your abstract to a maximum of 250 words including tables (excluding title and author information)
6. A structured abstract is preferred (Background, Methods, Results, Conclusion and Clinical implications)
7. Financial disclosures if any should be clearly made at the end of the abstract.
8. Presenting author must be a registered delegate. All abstracts have to be accompanied with registration number (or registration form along with the applicable registration fees)
9. DEADLINE for submission of abstract is Sept. 30th 2011. Abstracts received after this date will not be considered for presentation.
10. Those who wish to be considered for award session should clearly indicate in which award session they are contesting.
11. Presenter for ICS award should be below 30 years and for NCCP award below 35 years. please provide age proof along with abstract submission.
